Tudal Family enters its fifth decade operating the iconic Tudal Estate Vineyard & Winery in St. Helena.

Winemaker's Notes:

This 2009 Cabernet Sauvignon blend brings together the best of two distinct and world renowned wine regions. The Napa Cabernet is exclusively from Tudal estate vineyards which brings overlapping flavors of anise, leather and subtle blackberry. The Sonoma component from Dry Creek adds a red fruit component that is lush with flavors of raspberry, pomegranate and dried cranberries. The overall blend possesses sturdy structure but with approachable and supple tannin that is both velvety and mouth-filling. A hint of vanilla and spice on the finish comes from the French oak barrels the wine aged in for two years which completes the blend and adds to the overall complexity of the wine.

Vintage Notes:

The 2009 vintage could go down as one of the great underrated vintages. Cool summer weather patterns helped to slow the grape maturation process to allow for complex flavors and aromas to develop. This is ideal for Cabernet Sauvignon development and notable wines.
