2005 TUDAL WINERY
NAPA VALLEY ESTATE CABERNET SAUVIGNON

The 2005 growing season was ideally long and slow through ripening and maturity. The River Block grapes were harvested in late September in very good condition. A full two weeks later the more mature Old Vine block of Cabernet, planted on original root stock over 30-years ago, was harvested.

The 2005 vintage represents the 26th Tudal Estate Cabernet Sauvignon grown, produced, and bottled on site by the Tudal family. Both the River and Old Vine blocks were fermented separately in stainless steel tanks and gently pressed by our basket press into settling tanks. Aging for 28-months was completed in French oak. The wine was lightly fined prior to being hand bottled right on premise.

The wine shows full and complex aromas of caramel, truffle, leather, and tobacco. Robust and rustic flavors are comprised of cherry, plum, caramel, and cedar that continue to unfold for hours as the wine opens. A hallmark attribute for Tudal Estate Cabernets of fine grained tannins, and a silky finish is also present with this 2005.
