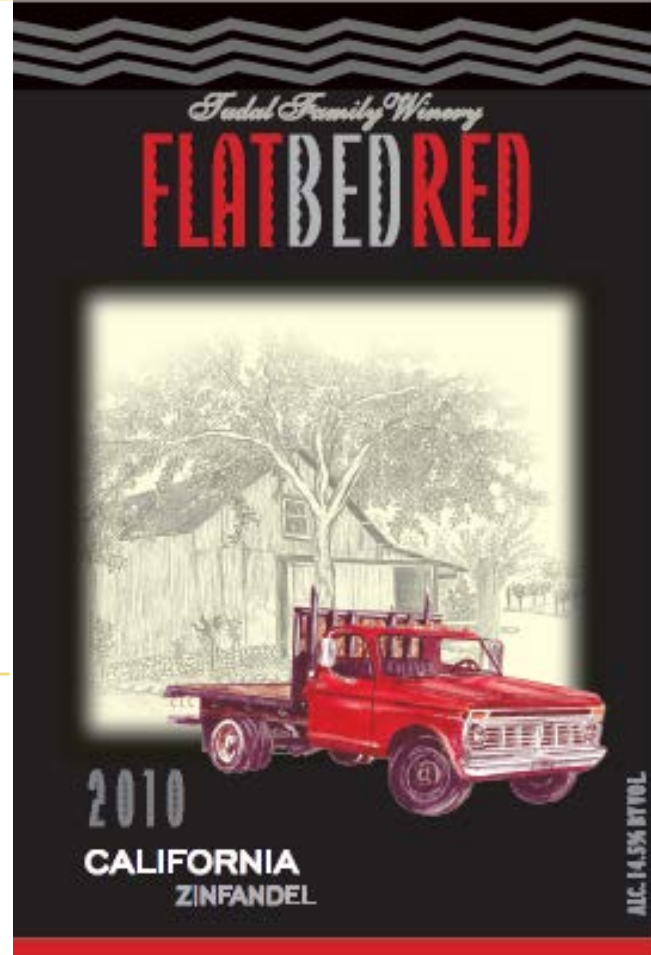

Winemaker's Notes:

This wine has a bright berry component with nuances of blueberry, blackberry and red raspberry. The subtle vanilla complements the berry component perfectly and rounds out the wine's complexity. The mouth feel is rich with big, but velvety tannin. Overall the wine is luscious and fruity with a solid backbone and tannin that wonderfully coats the mouth. This wine is ready to drink now and has some ageing potential in the near-term.
