## **Tasting Notes:**

This is a classic, Burgundian-style Pinot Noir. Immediately on the nose, one sniffs earthy aromas of white truffle that commingle with subtle floral notes reminiscent of potpourri and rose petal. Beneath the earthiness and adding to the wine's complexity, the wine exudes red fruit aromas of strawberry and black cherry.

## **Winemaker's Notes:**

The texture is silky smooth with lean acidity that allows the flavors to pop on the pallet where the strawberry and spice character dominates the long-lasting finish.

The wine truly reminds one of a classic Burgundy but clearly demonstrates what makes the Russian River an ideal terroir for growing Pinot Noir.
